#### **Quotes from Temple Head Coach Matt Rhule-**

- On being in the bowl: "On behalf of Temple University, our football team and really our entire campus, we are excited to be here. When the options came open, we were pretty resolute that this is where we wanted to be."
- On Palm Beach County: "The fact that the game is right before Christmas, so many fans and the families of our
  players are excited to come down here to enjoy the game and festivities but then enjoy the area. I think my family
  and I were thinking about staying for a couple days. Coming to such a beautiful place at this time of year is just
  wonderful for people like us that are from up North."
- On the meaning of a bowl win: "I had the pleasure of playing for Joe Paterno and he always said the bowl game
  was pivotal because it is the end of season but the first game of the next year. It builds momentum into the offseason and sets the tone for everything. Every time you put that Marmot Boca Raton Bowl shirt back on, you're going
  to remember how you played, so I think it is crucial for us."
- On Tyler Matakevich: "He is a tremendous player. His play speaks for itself, but he is an even better person. He hasn't missed a practice in four years. He loves the game. He's helped really set the tone for the program in my three years as head coach going and has really been the driving force, and I am proud to have coached him."

- On being in the bowl: "The Toledo Rockets are honored and excited to be here and be part of this game. The City
  of Boca Raton is an awesome destination city. I think it will provide an interesting experience for not only our players but for fans, coaches and staff that put in all the hard work and effort to make this such a great season."
- On Palm Beach County: "I'm sure our fans will enjoy being down here in the sunshine. Being able to come down
  here and recruit down here I think that there's a certain passion for the game of football and our great sport and I
  know our people will really relish in that."
- On the meaning of a bowl win: "I think for us at the University of Toledo, we do not take these opportunities for granted. I remember in 2013 we had a 7-5 football team and we did not make a bowl game. You're striving to win and gain momentum going into the offseason. The recruiting piece is also huge as well."
- On Kareem Hunt: "Kareem is a tremendous player, and I don't know Tyler (Matakevich), but one thing all these
  great players do is they teach coaches some lessons to. I think what Kareem does is bring a spirit to practice
  that's infectious and makes the guys around them better."
